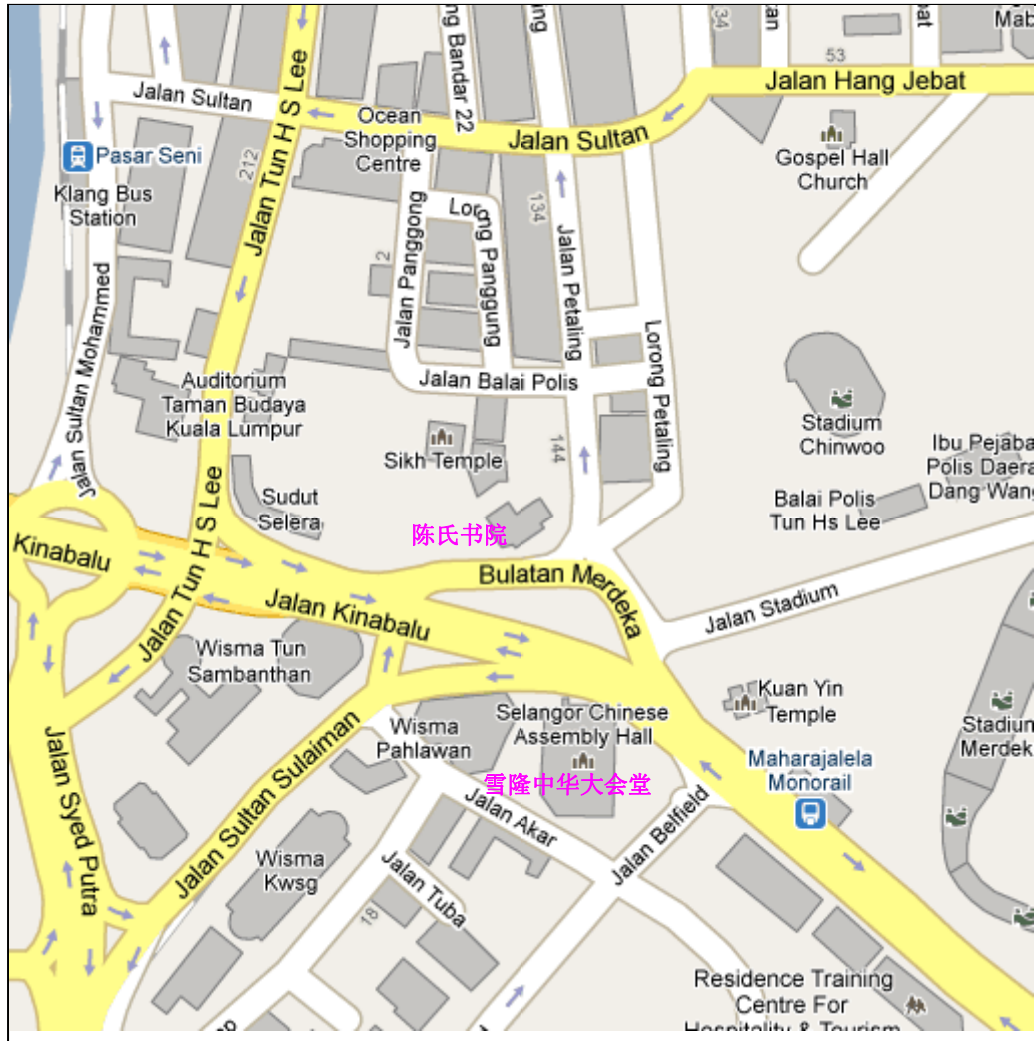

Puja :

Milarepa

Milarepa, the eleventh-century yogi and poet, is the most renowned saint in Tibetan Buddhist Society.

Milarepa is a holy but captivatingly human figure who developed from an avenging black magician to a supremely powerful yogi, pointing the way to spiritual liberation and complete self-knowledge.

Buddha Akshobhya

Buddha Akshobhya is blue in colour and is visualized in the East of the Dhyani Buddha Mandalas.

Akshobhya is the Lord of the Tathagata family. This Buddha Manifests Dharma, transforming hatred and aversion into the transcendental wisdom of the sphere of the Dharma.

Akshobhya's blessing enables us to develop the wisdom that understands the true nature of reality. This is often referred to as becoming awakened and overcoming ignorance.

THE SOJONG VOWS (8 PRECEPTS):

1. I shall not kill;
2. I shall avoid all sexual activities;
3. I shall not lie;
4. I shall completely abandon intoxicants (includes cigarettes and other toxic substances, except for medicinal purposes);
5. I shall not sit on high and luxurious seats;
6. I shall not take food at wrong times (no solid food after lunch till sunrise)
7. I shall not use perfume or wear ornament / jewellery (watches are allowed but avoid glaring or ornamental types);
8. I shall not sing or dance (including telling jokes)

PRAYER TIME:

1. Punctuality must be observed at each session
2. To prostrate to the Buddha and Deities upon entering the prayer hall
3. To stand up upon entrance of Rinpoche and/or Lama to the prayer hall
4. To prostrate to Rinpoche and/or Lama after they are seated
5. Do not distract others whilst prayers is in sessions
6. To prostrate to Rinpoche and/or Lama after completion of each prayer session
7. Strictly no hand phones are allowed, except recording devices.
